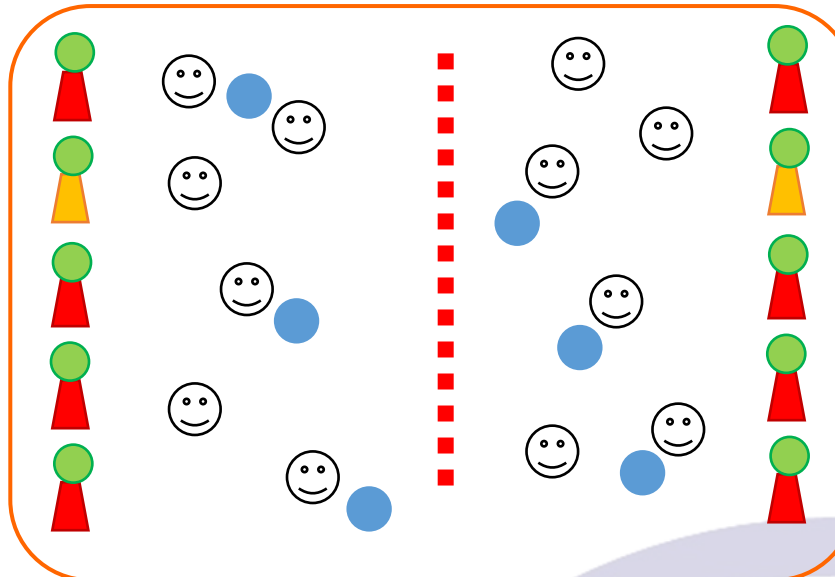


The Last Egg Standing

Age Group: Key Stage One & Key Stage Two

How to set up:

- ✓ Organise pupils into 2 teams.
- ✓ Place 5 cones at the back of each team with a ball (egg) balanced on top.
- ✓ Divide the playing area with a line of cones down the middle.
- ✓ Share the soft balls between the teams.



Equipment:

- ✓ Soft balls
- ✓ Tennis balls (eggs)
- ✓ Cones

How to score:

- ✓ At the end of each game, teams earn 1 point for each egg they have on their cones.
- ✓ Allocate one cone/egg to be the 'golden egg'. Teams earn 5 extra bonus points if their 'golden egg' is still on its cone.

How to Play:

- ✓ Each team must stay on their side of the playing area.
- ✓ When the game starts, pupils must attempt to roll or throw the soft balls towards the other team's eggs and attempt to knock them off the cones.
- ✓ Pupils are not allowed to put their eggs back on the cones if they are knocked off.
- ✓ Play the game for 2-3 minutes (or until one team loses all their eggs).
- ✓ **Safety:** choose one pupil from each team to be the 'egg collector' this player must collect and remove all fallen eggs from the area (ensure there are no tennis balls rolling around the playing area).
