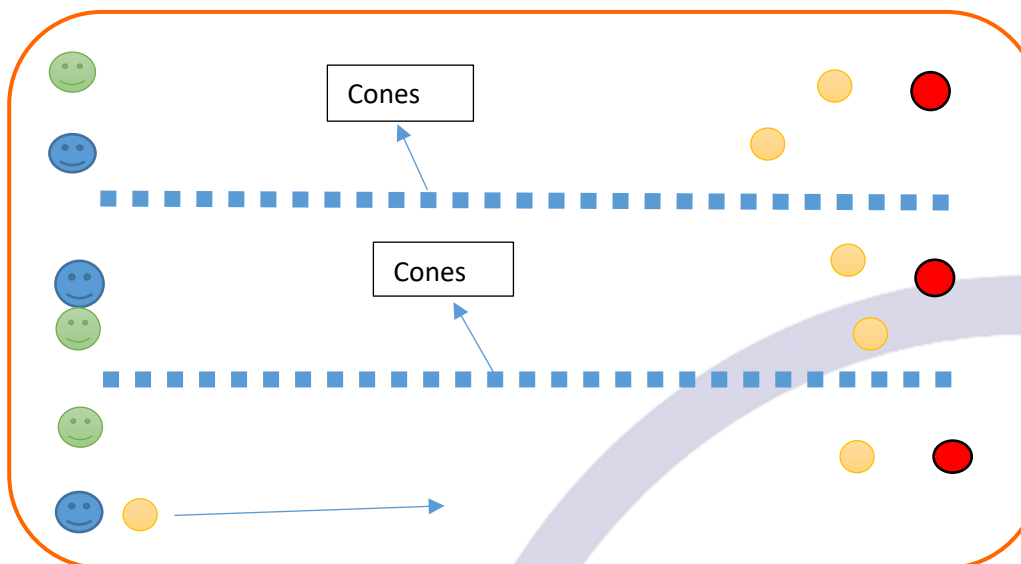


Red nose Bowls

Age Group: Key Stage One & Two

How to set up:

- ✓ Create lanes in the playing area with cones as shown in the diagram.
- ✓ Organise pupils into pairs (one pair per lane).
- ✓ Give each pupil a small ball.
- ✓ Each lane must have 1 red nose (the jack).



Equipment:

- ✓ Soft balls.
- ✓ Red nose for every lane.
- ✓ Cones.

How to score:

- ✓ The player whose ball lands closest to the red nose wins.

How to Play:

- ✓ Once the pairs are in their lanes, one pupil rolls the red nose down the lane.
- ✓ When the red nose stops, pupils take turns to roll their ball to get it as close to the red nose as possible.
- ✓ The participants can knock their opponents balls out of the way.
- ✓ Once everyone has rolled their ball down the lane, the player with the closest ball to the red nose wins 1 point.
- ✓ Repeat the game for several rounds, counting points up each time.
