

how to set up:

- Print and cut out the words from the book titles (see appendix).
- Randomly scatter the words at one end of the playing area and place a cone on top of each word.
- Organise pupils into teams of 4, lining up at the opposite end of the playing area, facing the word cones.



equipment:

- Cones.
- Word Cards.

how to score:


 1 point is scored for every correct book title.

how to play:

- One by one a member of each team runs out to find a word of the book title they have been told to collect.
- Each group needs to be given a book title to create.
- When a player runs to find a word, if it is the correct word they must return it to their group and start to build the title, if the word isn't what they are looking for they must place it back down under the cone, and run back to release the next player.
- Once a group has collected all the correct words and built their title, the teacher can then give them a second book title to find.

Progression: See 'Book Characters' activity below.





how to play:

- Ask children to find a space to work in.
- From the book titles above, call out a well-known book character.
- Children must move around acting as the character.
- Continue the activity changing the character every
 15 30 seconds.

Progression - ask individuals to choose their favourite book character, and move around as that character – thinking about how they move, how they act, facial expressions and speed.

Progression – In small groups, ask children to think of characters from a book. After some practise time, ask each group to act out the characters from the book, without speaking, and the rest of the class must try guess the book and the characters.
